UPDATES AND CORRECTIONS

Version 1.1

Phase 1

Calder: Robson, Charl(e)ton, Thompson, Stok(h)oe and Ridley – direct ancestors identified on the basis of census data.

Gatheridge: Charles Tatton was a bigamist and possibly not the father of Arthur Tatton contrary to the birth certificate. From his medical records, Arthur spent some time in Rainhill Asylum and four years a reformatory school.

Lindsay: Parents of Ann Saltern, great x 3 grandmother.

Phase 2:

Lindsay: Children and descendants of John Lindsay, great grandfather x 2.

Phase 3

Gatheridge: Long Line under review, parish registers available back to Richard Long, great x 8 grandfather, 17th century. Also wills and inventories found. Replacement of Anne Hadley by Mary ? as great x 8 grandmother marrying Richard Long and the removal of John Long and Elizabeth Watson and as a potential great x 9 grandparents for lack of evidence.
